### IN JOHNSTOWN

God has gathered us together by his Word and Spirit in Johnstown. We resolve to be good neighbors and faithful gospel witnesses in the neighborhoods around our church.

### THE GREATER JOHNSTOWN AREA

Trinity draws members and visitors from the greater-Johnstown area. We will continue to make disciples in our communities by equipping believers to live for Christ in the home, workplace, and their neighborhoods across our region. Furthermore, we will labor together to reach the lost with the good news of Christ Jesus.

### AROUND THE WORLD

North America: We resolve to a renewed focus on church planting in North America. Trinity will participate in the work of making disciples across our country by partnering with others to establish new churches. We also commit to support, send, and serve church planters.

Globally: 3.5 billion of the 7 billion people in the world remain unreached (no church presence, no access to the gospel). Statistics indicate that 95% of full-time Christian workers labor in reached parts of the world. Over six thousand people groups in the world remain unreached. In summary, there is a tremendous need for church planting where there are no gospel-proclaiming churches. Therefore, we resolve to pray and work to support and establish churches with special focus on unreached people groups.

## **Confession of Sin**

We do not care enough to confront, but when other Christians fail, we are quick to condemn them. We think the worst about others, rather than the best. We confess that we are not always willing to pay the high cost of discipleship. We try to be as worldly as we think we can get away with. We prefer to squeeze our faith in around the edges of life, rather than to let you stand at the center to control everything we are and have. We confess that we lack passion for missions and evangelism. We think of missions as something someone else does, somewhere else, rather than something you have called us to do right here and now. We confess that we lack compassion. We think it is important to help the needy, provided that someone else actually does the helping. In the name of Jesus, we ask forgiveness for these and all our sins. Amen.



**Q. 94. What is baptism?**

- A. Baptism is a sacrament, in which the washing with water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, signifies and seals our being ingrafted into Christ, and having a share in the benefits of the covenant of grace, and our engagement to be the Lord's.

**Q. 95. To whom is baptism to be administered?**

- A. Baptism is not to be administered to any outside of the visible church, until they profess their faith in Christ and obedience to him; but the infants of such as are members of the visible church are to be baptized.
